Vancouver reference types for EndNote

Last updated March 2021

This brief guide outlines what reference types to use in EndNote with the Vancouver Curtin X9 style.

When entering a reference into EndNote you only need to include the basic data – do not include formatting or punctuation such as commas, brackets or full stops unless stated otherwise.

In-text citations

In the Vancouver style, a consecutive number is allocated to each reference as it is cited for the first time in the text of the assignment and becomes the unique identifier for that source. If the source is cited again that same number is repeated. EndNote will assign and adjust the numbering in-text and in the reference list as you add citations to your Word document.

In-text citations should be inserted:

- After the author's name (if included in the sentence): Johnson¹ explains...
- To the <u>right</u> of commas and full stops: ...is a widely accepted theory.³
- To the left of colons and semi-colons: ...lists the following⁶: motivation
- Multiple sources can be inserted at a single reference point:

...is faced by many in the industry. 1,2,5-7

If citing different pages from a single source at different places in the text, page numbers can be included in the in-text citation and the source listed once in the reference list. Page numbers can be added for direct quotations, if necessary. **To add page numbers to a reference:**

- 1. Insert the reference in your Word document
- 2. Select Edit & Manage Citations in the EndNote toolbar
- 3. Ensure the citation is selected then enter the page number in brackets in the **Suffix** field e.g. (p83) then click OK

Journal title abbreviations

In the Vancouver style, journal titles are abbreviated. In EndNote, you will need to import the journals terms list to abbreviate the titles. Please see the EndNote essentials guide for more information.
