
Searching Koori Mail

Last updated November 2020

Koori Mail is a national fortnightly newspaper that focuses on the Indigenous people of Australia. Digitised copies of the Koori Mail are available online from the Australian Institute of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Studies (AIATSIS). Individual articles are not searchable on this site but a separate index, INFOKOORI, is provided by the State Library of New South Wales.

To find Koori Mail articles on your topic:

1. Go to [INFOKOORI](#)
2. Enter broad keywords into the search box and click **Search**
3. On the search results page, click on the title of the item to see further details
4. Note down the date (e.g. 17 Dec 2014) and page number (e.g. page 23) of the article
5. Next go to the [Koori Mail Online Collection](#)
6. In the **Year published** field, enter the year of the article (e.g. 2014) and click **Apply**
7. Browse to the relevant issue and scroll to the particular page (e.g. page 23)
